

Framework Conditions – GiardinaSTYLE

The GiardinaSTYLE area is dedicated to elegant, creative product presentations and high-quality artisan/manufacture stands. To ensure a consistent and high standard of quality, the following conditions apply to all participants:

Submission for Approval

Participation in the GiardinaSTYLE area requires the prior submission of a stand concept for review by the exhibition management.

The following documents must be submitted:

- Project plans and/or sketches
- Short project description
- Stand signage concept
- Material list (including fire protection classifications, etc.)
- Structural proof for elevated or multi-level constructions
- Technical specifications for electricity, water, and other connections
- Lighting plan (Note: floodlights are not permitted)

Stand Design Guidelines

- Lighting: The stand lighting is the responsibility of the main exhibitor. Since general hall lighting will be turned off during the event, a self-contained, well-designed lighting solution is required.
- Signage: Signage elements should be discreet and stylistically integrated into the overall design.
 Maximum size: 2 x 1 meters.
 Suspended boards, flags, beach flags, and banners are not permitted.
- Screens: Screens are allowed if they are harmoniously integrated into the booth design.
- Walls and Floors: Both interior and exterior walls, as well as flooring, must be thematically designed. Unfinished white surfaces, carpets, or bare hall floors are not permitted.
- Freestanding Elements: Structures such as terraces or scaffolding must be clad in a matching design.

These elements are subject to approval by the exhibition management.
